




THE WOMB ALIGNED PATH



GIFTS AND BLOCKS OF THE SEVENTH GRAIL GATE

Gifts of the Seventh Grail Gate

Psychic, Compassionate, Intuitive, Empathetic, Genius, Anointrix, Priestess Lineage, Womb Gnosis, Womb Shamaness, Feminine Light Body.

This space connects you to the tender feminine essence that embraces all of life. It is softly radiant and attracts love and nourishment effortlessly. It is the receptive channel that connects with other people, the cosmos, and earth wisdom. It is the seat of your psychic intuition. Women in touch with the water element of their Womb will have an almost supernatural power to intuit knowledge and feel others' emotions, and manifest synchronicities.

This element connects you to your soul mate with a deep psychic bond. Ideas that flow from this element are often paradigm changing—moments of true genius. This is the element associated with oracles and female priestesses through the ages, and connects to their Wisdom. It is the flow of Life, which Source speaks through.

Blocks of the Seventh Grail Gate

You find it difficult to connect to the magic of life, and are prone to judge others and yourself. You may have denial about the true extent of your emotional wounds, guarding and protecting them with anger and resistance. Your receptive channel is offline, because to open it would also mean a huge amount of grief flowing through. You feel life is against you. You struggle to relate to the masculine or surrender to love. You can be "spiky" or argumentative. Underneath your suspicion and anger is a deep feeling that you have to close your heart to survive. You often retreat into the intellectual realms and value control and career success.



Womb Mapping: Water Element

- 1.Sit in a cross-legged womb meditation, bring your hands into a prayer position in front of your heart, then rotate your joined hands forward, so they are now pointed outward straight in front of you. Bring them slowly apart so only your fingertips are touching. Feel the energy flowing, creating a womb space in front of your heart.
- 2. Move your energy and awareness to the left side of this womb grid mudra where your left knuckles are. Feel a connection between this point, and the left side of your womb and left ovary.
- 3. Begin to feel the energy of this area—any warmth, blocks, coldness, resistance.
- 4. Ask yourself the following questions, or just allow any insights and visions to arise.

Questions to Percolate in Your Womb Cauldron

- 1. What do you need to surrender to and release to let love in?
- 2. What makes you relax and feel as if you are "in the flow"?
- 3. What secret message is your intuition whispering to you?
